This year's Petit Verdot contains a small amount of the Estate Petit Verdot. Vibrant aroma and intense flavors of plum, fig, dark berry, espresso, mocha, and humidor. Petit Verdot is an important varietal for Cuda Ridge Wines and we hope you enjoy it!

Vineyard Notes: The grapes are sourced from Smith Ranch on the West Side of Livermore Valley (on Wetmore Road). The vineyard gets ample sun during the day and cooling at night. The vineyard block is large and Cuda Ridge has selected a premier set of rows which is hand-harvested each year at the precise chemistry desired by the winemaker. There is a small amount (1 barrel) of estate Petit Verdot included in the lot, the estate vineyard is meticulously maintained and this is the first release of the vineyards fruit.
