

Winemakers Notes: 2008 Malbec Livermore Valley

Description: Dark rich inky in color. Rich dark berry aromas with dark berries carrying through on the palate. This is bold wine, yet soft on the mid-palate with a long lasting berry finish. At 13.7% alcohol, this is a subtle wine that you can sit back, savor, and enjoy.

Varietals: 75% Malbec, 15% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Petit Verdot
