

Winemakers Notes: 2010 Petit Verdot Livermore Valley

Description: Dark and inky in color is your first warning that you are about to enjoy a bold, flavorful and intense wine. Bold berry fruit, tobacco, and chocolate on the nose that carries to the palate with soft mouthfeel and structured tannins. This is 100% Petit Verdot from Smith Ranch Vineyard on western side of Livermore.
