

Winemakers Notes: 2011 Black Label Cabernet Sauvignon Livermore Valley

Description: Cuda Ridge considers this a new world style Cabernet Sauvignon. This is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from the White Cat Vineyard in the Crane Ridge area of Livermore. This was aged for 18 months in American Oak. This one is for the Cab lover who likes deep and dark over zippy and racy. It's built firmly plush, with plenty of tasty stuffing to keep your interest. This is a Cab that keeps on surprising you.
