

Winemakers Notes: 2012 Malbec Livermore Valley

**<u>Description:</u>** It begins with a gorgeous, deep-dark plum-black color. Aromas of plum and white pepper. It positively explodes on the palate with ripe plums with an elegant mouthfeel. The tannins are ample and plump, yet this is a soft wine with a long lasting finish.

**Varietals:** 100% Malbec (White Vineyard & Ghielmetti Vineyards)

<u>Vineyard Notes:</u> The 2012 Malbec is a blend of two Livermore Valley vineyards, White Cat Vineyard and Ghielmetti Vineyard. The White Cat Vineyard is located in the rolling hills of Crane Ridge and the Ghielmetti Vineyard is located in the far eastern part of Livermore.
