



2017 Petit Verdot Livermore Valley

Deep dark in color with fruit on the nose of blueberry and lilac. Dark fruit and baking spices on the palate. Medium structured and consistency from beginning to end.

<u>Vineyard Notes</u>: The grapes are sourced from Smith Ranch on the West Side of Livermore Valley (on Wetmore Road). The vineyard gets ample sun during the day and cooling at night. The vineyard block is large and Cuda Ridge has selected a premier set of rows which is handharvested each year at the precise chemistry desired by the winemaker.
