



2018 Carménère Livermore Valley

Garnet red in color with an intense nose of dark berry, coco, spice and well integrated green pepper. Velvety mouthfeel with bold flavors of coco, chocolate, licorice, dark berry, baking spices and vegetal. Medium to bold tannins which are well rounded. Long evolving and juicy finish.

<u>Vineyard Notes:</u> The grapes are sourced from the Insel Family Vineyard located in Pleasanton, in the western portion of the Livermore Valley AVA. 369 certified Clone 6 vines on 110R rootstock using modified VSP trellis. Vineyard is flat with soil that is sandy Loam to loam. Vineyard was planted on May 31, 2014 with initial harvest in 2018.
