



2019 Carménère Livermore Valley

This second harvest of Carménère from the Insel Family Vineyard is Garnet red in color with an intense nose of dark coco, green pepper, and spices. It has a soft and velvet mouthfeel with bold flavors of coco, chocolate, baking spices, clove, green pepper, fig and dark berry. Well balanced and rounded tannins. The finish is long and evolving.

<u>Vineyard Notes:</u> The grapes are sourced from the Insel Family Vineyard located in Pleasanton, in the western portion of the Livermore Valley AVA. 369 certified Clone 6 vines on 110R rootstock using modified VSP trellis. Vineyard is flat with soil that is sandy Loam to loam. Vineyard was planted on May 31, 2014 with initial harvest in 2018.
