



2016 Malbec Livermore Valley

This low alcohol (12.5%), White Cat Vineyard Malbec, has delicate fruit, violet, and oak complexity on the nose and palate. The solid acid structure adds a crispness throughout. This is a well balanced wine which is quite approachable at such a young age.

<u>Vineyard Notes:</u> The 2015 Malbec is sourced from the White Cat Vineyard and Ghielmetti Vineyards, both located on the east side of Livermore. White Cat is located in the rolling hills of Crane Ridge area. The vineyard gets good sun exposure and afternoon breezes which provide night cooling which is ideal for sugar generation in the berries while maintaining the acid balance. The Ghielmetti Vineyard is one of the most eastern vineyards in Livermore and has a much cooler micro-climate.
