



2019 Petit Verdot Livermore Valley

Well-rounded nose of dark fruit with light touch of oak. Blueberry, baking spices, and violet on the palate. Nice tannin and acid balance on mid-palate with long finish.

<u>Vinevard Notes</u>: The majority (88%) of the grapes are sourced from Smith Ranch on the West Side of Livermore Valley (on Wetmore Road). The vineyard gets ample sun during the day and cooling at night. The vineyard block is large and Cuda Ridge has selected a premier set of rows which is hand-harvested each year at the precise chemistry desired by the winemaker. One barrel of the lot (12%) comes from the Estate vineyard located at the winery. This vineyard is farmed for exceptional quality.
